KEY CRITERIA

- **English:** Good level of English B1/B2 (Intermediate Level)
- **Work status:** Right to Work has been accepted
- **Attendance:** They can be currently employed but able to physically attend

- **Virtual meet up** explaining more about the programme and opportunities for employment introduction; understanding applicants skills, level of English, work experience and career intentions; to discuss programme suitability
