

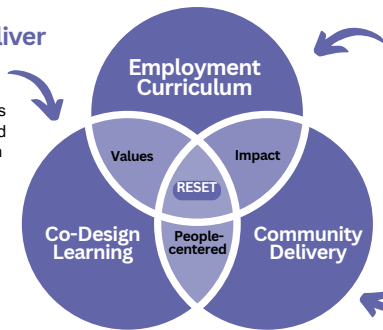
WHAT IS RESET?

FACEWORK'S RESET PROGRAMME is an innovative and radical new delivery model being piloted by Facework for supporting refugees into work. It is based on the simple principle that those with lived-experience of migration who are already settled in the UK, are ideally placed to train and support refugee communities to find good quality work opportunities and integrate into local communities.

What is distinctive about RESET model is that we combine 3 key elements into one programme. Training participants on how to deliver employability training, how to make this training impactful, and how to deliver this in a community setting.
